What is a Mastermind?

It refers to a peer-to-peer mentoring group designed to help members solve their problems with input and advice from the other group members. The idea is that by bringing together diverse minds, participants can leverage each other's experiences, skills, and perspectives to gain insights and find solutions they might not have discovered alone. ***The Principal Leadership Mastermind has the added bonus of expert facilitation and support by veteran principals and certified executive coaches.***

What is the cost of participation?

\$595 for full year participation. \$395 for single semester participation.
